to Participate in Regional Joint Mitigation Resiliency Project

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Chair to execute an Interagency Agreement with East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to Participate in Regional Joint Mitigation Resiliency Project for a total fixed fee amount of \$237,111.25.

BACKGROUND:

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has awarded a \$1.499 million Rebuild Florida Community Development Block Grant General Planning Support Program grant to the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to complete a Regional Joint Mitigation Resiliency Project.

The East Central Florida Regional Planning Council is entering into interagency agreements with the regional planning councils that have counties that were declared federal disaster areas as a result of Hurricane Irma to assist in completing the project. These regional planning councils include Central Florida Regional Planning Council, Northeast Florida Regional Council, North Central Florida Regional Planning Council, Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council and the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council.

The regional planning councils will engage in cross collaboration to provide a seamless network of community partners setting forth a single consistent methodology for vulnerability, risk analysis and assessments with reduced focus on county boundaries in order to identify potential multi-jurisdictional or multi-county solutions. The project will fill an identified gap in resilience efforts by focusing on the impacts of flooding hazards to the inland counties in Florida.

The scope of work will include the following activities.

- Future Extreme Rainfall Modeling;
- Mitigation Needs Assessment, Template and Mitigation Priority Areas and Project List;
- Small Area Mitigation Plans;
- Regional Resilience Exposure Tool;
- Interactive Best Practice Application; and
- Stakeholder Engagement.

The Council will be paid a total fixed fee amount of \$237,111.25 over a three-year period by the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council for these services.

Recommend that the Council amend Section 6 Officers-Duties-Term of Office and Section 8 Standing and Special Committees of the Council Bylaws to delete the Secretary-Treasurer officer position, delete the Executive Committee Member position, add a separate Treasurer officer position, add a separate Secretary officer position, and delete the review of amendments to developments of regional impact as a duty of the Clearinghouse Committee to be effective May 26, 2022.

Please find attached proposed amendments to the Council Bylaws in underline and strike through format. Words bolded and underlined are proposed to be added and words bolded and struck through are proposed to be deleted.

The following is a list of the bylaws proposed amendments to Section 6 Officers-Duties-Term of Office and Section 8 Standing and Special Committees.

- 1. Delete the Secretary-Treasurer officer position;
- 2. Delete the Executive Committee Member position;
- 3. Add a separate Treasurer officer position;
- 4. Add a separate Secretary officer position; and
- 5. Delete the review of amendments to developments of regional impact as a duty of the Clearinghouse Committee.

Section 6: Officers---Duties---Term of Office.

- The members of the Council shall elect a Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary Treasurer and Secretary to serve as officers of the Council. The officers shall be elected from among the members of the Council and may be elected or gubernatorial appointees no more than one (1) of who may be from representatives appointed by the same general purpose local governmental unit and no more than one (1) may be a gubernatorial appointee from the same county as another gubernatorial appointee. When a vacancy occurs among the officers, the vacancy shall be filled in the same manner in which the preceding officers were originally elected.
- (2) The officers shall perform the duties enumerated below and other duties prescribed by the Council:
 - (a) The Chair shall preside at meetings of the Council and of the Board; sign, with the counter-signature of the Secretary–**Treasurer**, or Executive Director, as authorized by the Council, any contracts or other instruments which is deemed in the Council's best interest; and perform such other duties incident to the office as may be prescribed by the Council.
 - (b) The Vice-Chair shall assist the Chair in the performance of the Chair's duties, and either in the absence of the Chair or in the event of the Chair's inability or refusal to act, shall have the powers and shall perform the duties of the Chair.
 - The Secretary-Treasurer shall see that minutes of the meetings and the records of the Council are kept; attest the signatures of the Council officers; and see that notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law.

 Further, the Secretary shall, in general, perform all duties that may be assigned to him/her by the Chair or the Council.
 - (d)(c) The Secretary—Treasurer shall, see that proper financial records of the Council are maintained in accordance with generally accepted governmental accounting principles. Further, the Secretary—Treasurer shall, in general, perform all duties that may be assigned to him/her by the Chair or the Council.
- (3) Each member elected to an office shall serve for one (1) year or until a successor is elected, and shall not be eligible for reelection to the same officer position in a succeeding year once their service for the one (1) year term of office has been completed and provided that the immediate past-Chair shall not be eligible to be elected to another officer **or Executive Committee**member position until two (2) years have elapsed following the end of their term as immediate past-Chair nor shall an elected official immediate past-Chair be succeeded in the office of Chair by a representative appointed by the same general purpose governmental unit or a gubernatorial appointee from the same county as another gubernatorial appointee.
- (4) Newly elected officers shall be declared installed following the election, and shall assume the duties of office upon adjournment of the Annual Meeting at which they are elected.

Section 8: Standing and Special Committees.

- (1) There shall be maintained four standing committees as follows:
 - (a) Executive Committee.
 - The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Council officers and the immediate past-Chair, or another Council member selected by the Council if the immediate past-Chair is not a member of the Council, and one (1) additional member selected by the Council.
 - 2. The Executive Committee shall have the duty to conduct the business of the Council between regular meetings and advise the Council of matters of day-to-day operations. Any action taken by the Executive Committee between regular meetings shall be placed on the agenda to be ratified by the Council at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
 - 3. In the event the Council fails to assemble a quorum for the purpose of transacting business at any regular or called meeting, the Executive Committee is authorized to act on behalf of the Council at the time and place of a scheduled meeting. In such instances, all members of the Council who are present may vote on items considered by the Executive Committee, and a majority of those voting shall decide any question under consideration. Actions of the Executive Committee shall be final.
 - 4. The Executive Committee shall also act as the Personnel Committee for the Council.
 - (b) Finance Committee.

The Finance Committee shall be composed of two (2) Council members appointed by the Chair and ratified by the Council, and the **Secretary**-Treasurer who shall be the Finance Committee Chair. The purpose of the Finance Committee shall be to develop and to recommend an annual budget and budget amendment(s) to the Council for consideration. The Finance Committee shall also, review the annual financial audit of the Council and recommend the annual financial audit to the Council for consideration.

(c) Program Committee.

The Program Committee shall be composed of eight (8) members appointed by the Chair and ratified by the Council, and the Vice-Chair who shall be the Program Committee Chair. The purpose of the Program Committee shall be to develop and recommend an Annual Work Program (Overall Program Design) to the Council for consideration.

(d) Clearinghouse Committee.

The Clearinghouse Committee shall be composed of nine (9) Council members appointed by the Chair and ratified by the Council. The Clearinghouse Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- 1. To review amendments to Developments of Regional Impact and make recommendations to the Council for final action;
- **2** <u>1</u>. To review proposals to nominate for consideration possible Areas of Critical State Concern and make recommendations to the Council for final action;

- 3 2. To review comprehensive plans or amendments thereto of local governments and make recommendations to the Council for final action, except in the case of comprehensive plans or amendments thereto of local governments which require action prior to the next regular meetings of the Council, in which case, the Clearinghouse Committee is delegated the responsibility for forwarding comments to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity or its successor agency pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes as amended, and local governments; and
- To provide policy oversight to staff reviews of proposals/projects submitted to the Council for review pursuant to Presidential Executive Order 12372 and Gubernatorial Executive Order 83-150, the Intergovernmental Coordination and Review Process.

The Clearinghouse Committee shall develop procedures where necessary to guide actions of the Clearinghouse Committee and staff and present the proposed procedures to the Council for approval.

(2) Special Ad Hoc or Advisory Committees.

The Council shall establish and maintain such Special Ad Hoc or Advisory Committees as it deems necessary to carry out the purposes and objectives of the Council. Special Ad Hoc or Advisory Committees shall be created or dissolved by the Chair subject to approval of the Council.

(3) Committee Appointment.

All committees and chairpersons thereof shall be appointed by the Council Chair subject to ratification by the Council unless otherwise provided herein.
