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

Chair Lorene Thomas called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES - April 25, 2013

Chair Thomas asked that the minutes for the April 25, 2013 Executive Committee meeting be approved as written.

- ACTION: Commissioner Spooner made the motion, with a second by Mayor Nobles, to approve the minutes of the Executive Committee meeting held on April 25, 2013 as written. The motion carried unanimously.
- II. CONTRACTS AND APPLICATIONS
 - A. Agreement with Florida Division of Emergency Management for Local Emergency Planning Committee, Fiscal Year 2013-14
 - ACTION: Commissioner Thomas made the motion, with a second by Commissioner Spooner, to recommend that the Council authorize the Chair to execute an agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management for Fiscal Year 2013-14 to provide the services to the North Central Florida Local Emergency Planning Committee as described below for an anticipated amount not to exceed \$40,909. The motion carried unanimously.
 - B. Agreement with Florida Division of Emergency Management for Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness - Fiscal Year 2013-14
 - ACTION: Commissioner Spooner made the motion, with a second by Commissioner Thomas, to recommend that the Council authorize the Chair to execute an agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management for an anticipated amount of \$52,604 in training and planning funds, on behalf of the North Central Florida Local Emergency Planning Committee, for Fiscal Year 2013-14. The motion carried unanimously.

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- C. Agreement with the City of High Springs for Comprehensive Planning Assistance Services - Fiscal Year 2012-13
- ACTION: Commissioner Thomas made the motion, with a second by Commissioner Spooner, to recommend that the Council authorize the Chair to execute a technical assistance services agreement to assist the City of High Springs with processing comprehensive plan amendments and land development regulation amendments and reviewing site and development plans and subdivision plats for Fiscal Year 2012-13, for a fixed fee amount of \$5,000. The motion carried unanimously.
- D. Purchase Order with the Northeast Florida Regional Council to Assist with Updating the Statewide Hurricane Evacuation Study
- ACTION: Commissioner Spooner made the motion, with a second by Mayor Nobles, to authorize the Council to provide services pursuant to a purchase order with the Northeast Florida Regional Council to assist with updating the Statewide Hurricane Evacuation Study for a fixed fee amount of \$13,000. The motion carried unanimously.
- E. Purchase Order with Northeast Florida Regional Council to Assist with Interoperable Workshop
- ACTION: Commissioner Thomas made the motion, with a second by Mayor Nobles, to authorize the Council to assist the Northeast Florida Regional Council with additional Interoperable Communications implementation, planning and documentation pursuant to a purchase order for a fixed fee amount of \$4,000. The motion carried unanimously.
- III. PROGRAM REPORT Resolution Recommending Designation of a Combined Designated Service Area and Supporting Establishment of a Multi-County Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board for Columbia, Hamilton and Suwannee Counties
 - ACTION: Commissioner Thomas made the motion, with a second by Commissioner Spooner, to recommend that the Council adopt Resolution 2013-07 recommending the designation of Columbia, Hamilton and Suwannee Counties by the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged as a combined designated service area under Florida's Transportation Disadvantaged Program and supporting the establishment of a multi-county Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board for Columbia, Hamilton and Suwannee Counties. The motion carried unanimously.

SUBJECT: Purchase Order with Northeast Florida Regional Council to Assist with Developing a Vulnerable Population Template

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Council to provide services pursuant to a purchase order with the Northeast Florida Regional Council to assist with developing a template to help collect and quantify local vulnerable population data for a fixed fee amount of \$8,000.

BACKGROUND:

In emergency preparedness and response, the Center for Disease Control defines vulnerable populations as groups whose needs are not fully addressed by traditional service providers or who feel they cannot comfortably or safely access and use the standard resources offered in emergency preparedness, relief and recovery. The Council has been asked to provide technical assistance to the Northeast Florida Regional Council by developing a template to collect and quantify local vulnerable population data.

The Council will be paid a fixed fee amount of \$8,000 by the Northeast Florida Regional Council to assist with this project.

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:
