



    - □ City of Gainesville Traffic Management System
      - □ Makes real time adjustments to traffic signals resulting in increased capacity
      - □ Installed on 214 of 230, 93% of traffic signals countywide

    - Provided access to employment, healthcare, education and other life-sustaining activities for elderly, disabled or

low-income residents

- □ Provided over 791,000 trips in region
- Majority of trips were provided for medical purposes




#### □ Revenues \$1.9 million
