



I. BUSINESS MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Due to Chair Delaney's absence, Commissioner Hawkins called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A. 2011/2012 Annual Operations Report

Ms. Lynn Godfrey, Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization Senior Planner, stated that MV Transportation is required to submit an Annual Operations Report to the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged by September 15 of each year. She said MV Transportation's 2011-2012 Annual Operations Report is included in the meeting packet for the Board's review.

The Board reviewed the Annual Operations Report

B. Elect Vice Chair

Ms. Godfrey stated that Ms. Staci Graff resigned from the Board. Therefore, she said the Board needs to elect a new Vice-Chair.

ACTION: Alana McKay moved to elect Mr. Jeff Lee as the Board's Vice-Chair. Christine Louton seconded; motion passed unanimously.

C. Rural Area Capital Equipment Support Grant Application

Ms. Godfrey stated that MV Transportation has applied for Rural Area Capital Equipment Support Grant funds to purchase two replacement vehicles. She said the Board needs to review and approve MV Transportation's grant application in order to be awarded grant funds.

ACTION: Jeff Lee moved to approve MV Transportation's application for Rural Area Capital Equipment Support Grant funds. Kyle Morrison seconded; motion passed unanimously.

D. Operations Reports

The Board reviewed MV Transportation's operations reports.

IV. OTHER BUSINESS

A. Members

Chair DeLaney announced that this will be her last meeting as Chair of the Board. She said she has enjoyed working with the Board to improve transportation services to transportation disadvantaged residents of Alachua County.

The Board thanked Commissioner DeLaney for her service on the Board.

Chairman Hawkins stated that the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners and the Gainesville City Commission worked together to develop a transportation plan to address unmet transportation needs in the City of Gainesville and Alachua County. He said the Commissioners included projects for public transportation, bus rapid transit, new roads and road repair as part of the plan.

However, he said the Alachua County Commission decided to place a "Fix our Roads" referendum on the November ballot that, if passed, will approve a 15-year three-fourthcent sales surtax for road repair. He said that, if this surtax passes, none of the funds can be used for public transportation, bicycle or pedestrian projects.

Commissioner Hawkins said the City of Gainesville Commission approved a resolution opposing the referendum because none of the funds could be used for public transportation, bus rapid transit, bicycle or pedestrian transportation projects. He said the Board may be interested in this surtax referendum because it will affect the transportation disadvantaged population.

Commissioner DeLaney discussed her concerns with allowing tax revenue to only be used for road repair and improvements. She said that, as fuel prices increase, more people will depend on public transportation and other transportation options as alternatives to personal automobiles.

Commissioner DeLaney thanked everyone who attended the Alachua County Commission meeting to support continued funding of the Regional Transit System Route 75.

B. Citizens

Ms. Jesse Pete commended MV Transportation and their staff for providing excellent service.

BACKGROUND:

The Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged requires that the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization for the Gainesville Urbanized Area use a competitive request for proposals process to select Community Transportation Coordinators at the end of each contract period.

MV Transportation, Inc. is the designated Community Transportation Coordinator for Alachua County. MV Transportation's Memorandum of Agreement will expire June 30, 2013. Therefore, the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization must use a competitive request for proposals process to select a Community Transportation Coordinator for Alachua County.

Any proposals submitted by the deadline will be scored and ranked by a Technical Review Committee. The Technical Review Committee's scores and rankings will be provided to the Board for review. The Board may provide non-binding comments concerning proposals to the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization.

The Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization will review the recommendation of the Technical Review Committee and any comments provided by the Board and forward a recommendation to the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged including any terms of designation. The Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged will make the final designation.


