The Lafayette County Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board will hold a public workshop **Monday, May 10, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.** in the Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. Senior/Client Services Center located on State Road 27 in Mayo, Florida.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention social/physical distancing guidelines will be followed in the meeting room. Wearing of face coverings will be required. Meeting participants must stay at least six feet (about two arms' length) from other persons. Due to social distancing requirements, there will be limitations on the number of persons permitted to enter the meeting room and/or building. 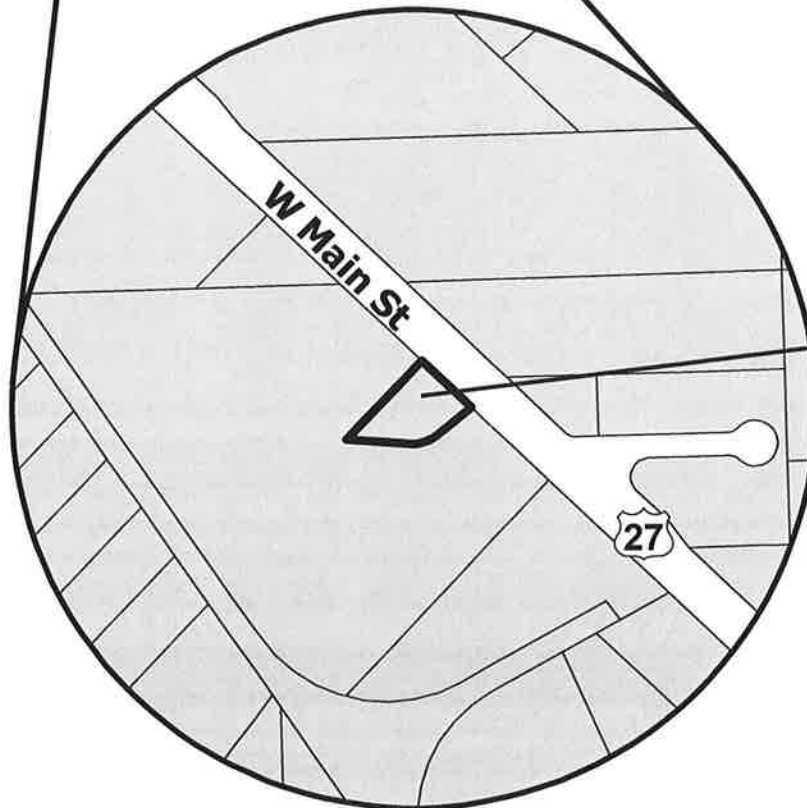
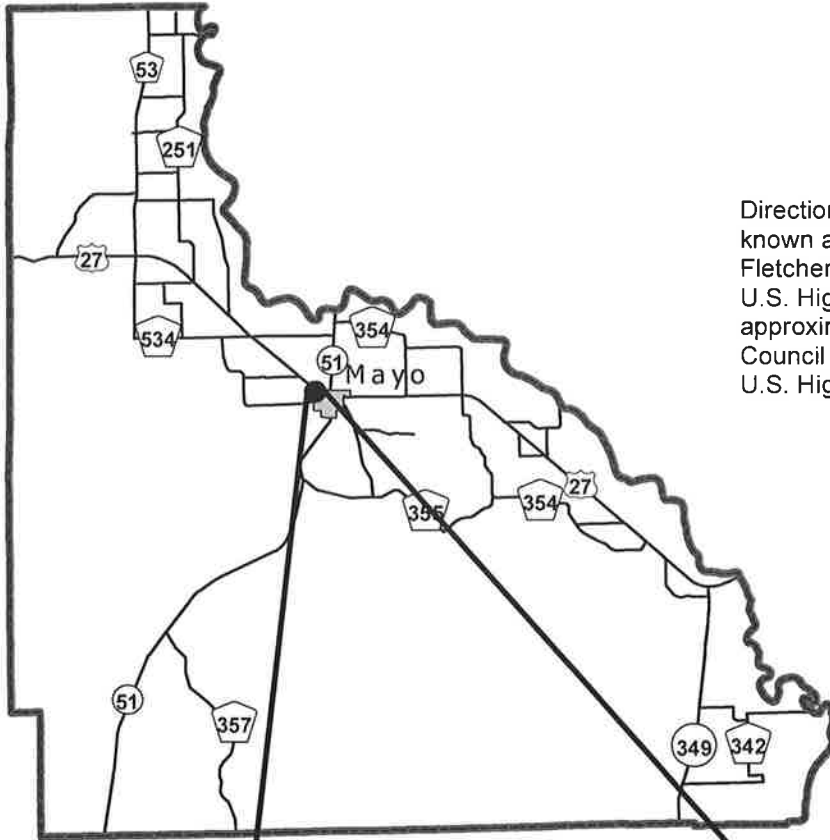
